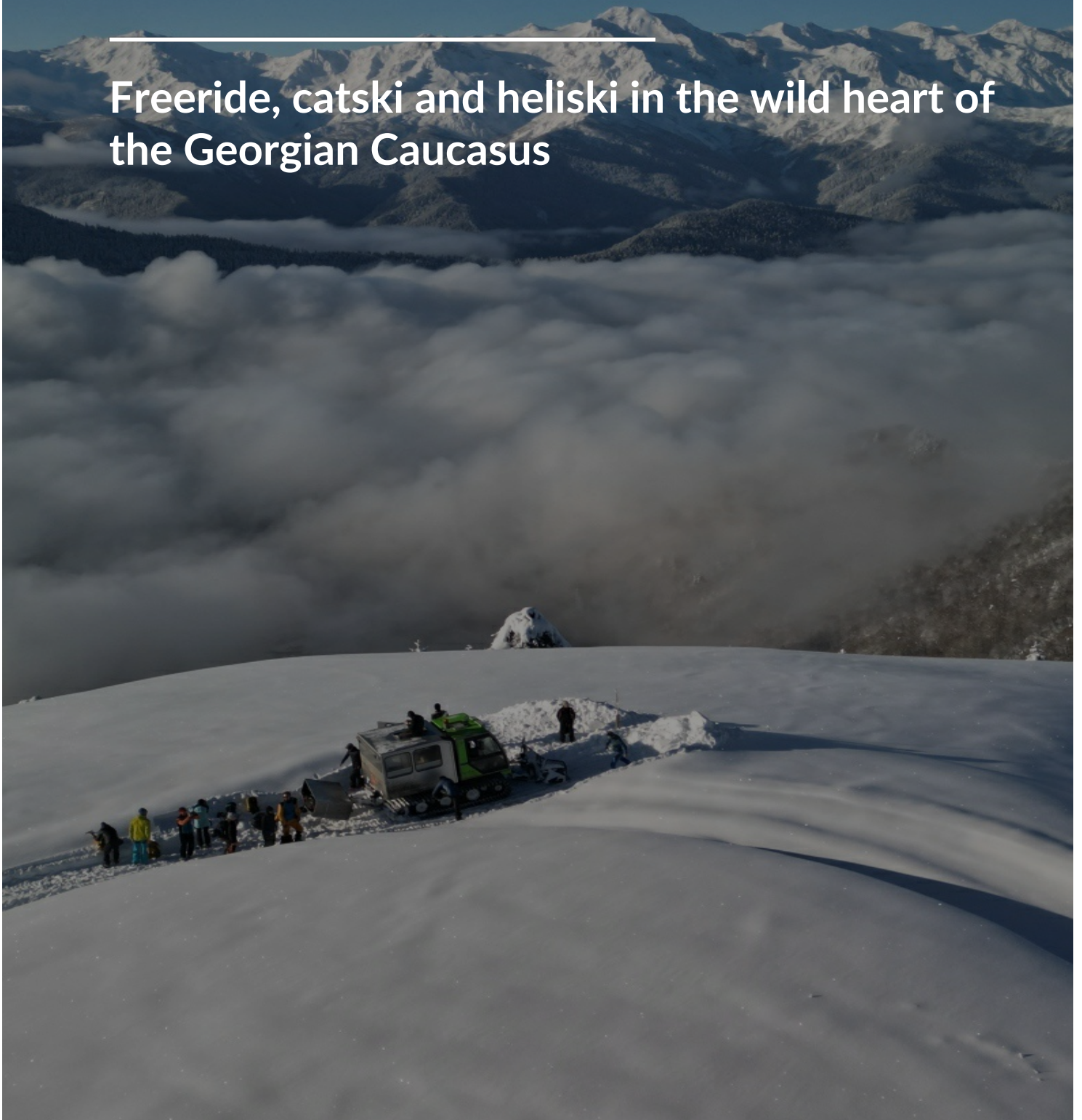

Itinerary

DAY 1: ARRIVAL IN KUTAISI AND TRANSFER TO MESTIA

Pickup at Kutaisi airport or city center and road transfer to Mestia, in the Svaneti region. The journey lasts approximately five hours and allows gradual entry into the remote Caucasus environment. Arrival at the hotel, room allocation, rest and first dinner at the accommodation before starting the skiing program.

Accommodation: 4* Hotel in Mestia

Meals: Dinner

DAY 2: FREERIDE IN TETNULDI

Full first day of activity at Tetnuldi, the great freeride reference in Svaneti and one of the venues of the Freeride World Tour. Thanks to its access to high alpine terrain, it offers wide possibilities to link off-piste descents, check equipment and start the week with a very complete day aimed at skiers used to moving on untreated snow.

Accommodation: 4* Hotel in Mestia

Meals: Breakfast and dinner

DAY 3: SECOND DAY OF FREERIDE IN TETNULDI

We return to Tetnuldi to continue exploring its freeride lines and make the most of another day with lifts and quick access to off-piste terrain. The resort stands out for its altitude, alpine environment and variety of descents available, from wide slopes to more committed routes, always depending on conditions and group level.

Accommodation: 4* Hotel in Mestia

Meals: Breakfast and dinner

DAY 4: CATSKI IN SVANETI

Full catski day from 9:30 to 15:00 in an area near Tetnuldi resort. For this day we will focus on area 1, always depending on weather forecast and snow conditions, making 6-7 descents between 500 and 600 meters of vertical drop with the help of the snowcat.

Accommodation: 4* Hotel in Mestia

Meals: Breakfast and dinner

DAY 5: SECOND CATSKI DAY

Full catski day from 9:30 to 15:00 in an area near Tetnuldi resort. For this second day we will move to another area, always depending on weather forecast and snow conditions, making 9-11 descents between 300 and 400 meters of vertical drop with the help of the snowcat.

Accommodation: 4* Hotel in Mestia

Meals: Breakfast and dinner

DAY 6: HELISKI IN THE CAUCASUS

Highlight day of the trip. The heliski activity is carried out with an AS350 B3 helicopter and is planned as the main experience of the program. The operation is organized in 3 groups, with 3 subgroups of 4 people, each with their guide. Among the 3 groups a total of 4 hours of effective flight is contemplated. The order of heliski with respect to catski and freeride can be changed during the week according to weather and availability.

Accommodation: 4* Hotel in Mestia

Meals: Breakfast and dinner

DAY 7: RETURN TO KUTAISI AND END OF TRIP

After breakfast, departure from Mestia and return transfer to Kutaisi. End of services. If you want to extend the experience, this program can be extended with more days of activity, always subject to availability and conditions.

Meals: Breakfast

Payment and cancellation policy

Initial booking: To secure your place, an initial payment of 40% of the total trip amount is required at the time of booking.

Final payment: The remaining amount, equivalent to 60% of the total, must be paid no later than 60 days before the departure date.

Extras: Additional trip costs, such as insurance, flights or other optional services, must be paid in full at the time of booking.

Cancellation insurance: The client may take out travel cancellation insurance in order to obtain a refund of the full amount paid, according to the terms and conditions of the policy purchased.

The end user may withdraw from the contracted trip, being entitled to a refund of the amounts paid, except for the penalties indicated. However, once the trip has been confirmed, the following amounts must be paid to the agency.

Full refund within 24 hours after purchase.

Up to 60 days before the trip: refund of 50% of the trip amount, except for management fees and any non-refundable amounts already committed.

For periods of less than 60 days before the trip: no refund will be made.

*A management fee of €100 will apply.

*If there are other non-refundable expenses already issued or committed with suppliers, these will also not be refunded and will be deducted from the total amount to be refunded.

*In this program, the amount of €1,500 corresponding to the reservation of the heliski date is non-refundable in the event of cancellation by the client, at any time after the booking has been confirmed, unless the client finds another person who can take their place.

*If the helicopter activity cannot be carried out due to operational reasons beyond the client's control, such as bad weather or mechanical failure of the helicopter, the specific amount of €1,500 corresponding to the heli date reservation will be fully refunded after the end of the trip.

*The cancellation cost of already issued flights is 100% of the ticket price.

Off Trail S.L. acts in this package travel arrangement as a retailer/commercial agent. For open scheduled departures, the operation of the trip requires a minimum of 8 confirmed registered participants, and the traveller will be informed through the client portal once this minimum has been reached in order to confirm the departure. If the minimum number indicated is not reached, the organizer may cancel the trip and notify the traveller within the applicable legal period of up to 20 calendar days before departure. For private departures or tailor-made trips, the program will be considered confirmed from the acceptance of the booking, as it is a trip specifically designed for the number of people indicated in the contract and with a price adjusted to that configuration. In the event of cancellation due to the required minimum not being reached, the traveller will be entitled to a full refund of the amounts paid, without any additional compensation.

Equipment list

Ski equipment

- Your ski equipment: skis/splitboard, poles and ski boots.
- Ski bag and boot bag.
- Avalanche safety equipment in backpack, shovel, probe, DVA transmitter/receiver and airbag.

Other recommended/necessary items on these trips, in addition to travel gear:

- Ski socks
- Mountain ski pants.
- Thermal shirt (base layer).
- Fleece or similar (mid layer).
- Gore-Tex style jacket and pants (outer layer).
- Light and thin primaloft or down jacket.
- Neck gaiter.
- Thin polar-type gloves and thick gloves.
- Cold hat and sun cap.
- Sunglasses and snow goggles
- Headlamp.
- Water bottle or thermos, minimum 1 liter. If you choose a Camelbak type bag, note that the tube can freeze, so it is advisable to carry an auxiliary bottle.
- Sunscreen and lip protection.
- Snacks (bars, gels, nuts...) to eat on the mountain during outings.

Optional: spare batteries, camera, powerbank, first aid kit.

FAQs

What type of trip is this?

It is a freeride program in Georgia based in Mestia, in the Svaneti region. It combines 2 days of freeride in Tetnuldi, 2 days of catski and 1 day of heliski, with 4* hotel, breakfasts, dinners and transfers included. The idea is to offer a very complete week for riders who want to maximize descents and terrain variety.

How many actual activity days does the program have?

The program includes 5 days of snow activity. Added to that is the arrival day with transfer from Kutaisi to Mestia and the final return day. It is a proposal designed to concentrate the main part of the trip in five intense off-piste skiing days. The program can be customized and more activity days added.

Where is the trip held?

The trip takes place in Georgia, in the Svaneti region, with the main base in Mestia. The freeride days focus on Tetnuldi and the special catski and heliski days take place in operational areas of the same region, depending on weather and available logistics.

What is the closest airport and how do you get to the starting point?

The planned entry point is Kutaisi. Pickup can be made at Kutaisi airport or city center, and from there a road transfer of about five hours is made to Mestia, where the skiing week really begins.

What technical and physical level should I have?

It is a trip aimed at freeride skiers with good off-piste skills. You should feel comfortable skiing untreated snow and moving in winter mountain terrain.

Is it designed for piste skiers?

No. This program is clearly focused on off-piste skiers and riders. The essence of the trip is to seek lines on unprepared terrain, combine lifts, catski and heliski, and adapt each day to the best available snow and safety conditions.

What is special about Tetnuldi for freeride?

Tetnuldi offers quick access to high alpine terrain, with abundant powder snow and a great variety of off-piste lines. It is a highly valued area for its open mountain feel, wide slopes and the remote character of the environment, far from the large crowds of other resorts.

What relevance does it have that Tetnuldi is one of the venues of the Freeride World Tour?

Tetnuldi's inclusion in the Freeride World Tour circuit reinforces its international prestige within freeride and confirms the huge potential of the area for this type of skiing. For you, this translates into a destination with serious terrain, great vertical drop and an increasingly consolidated reputation among high-level riders.

How many days of catski are included in the trip?

It includes 2 days of catski. These days are designed to access remote terrain with the help of the snowcat and maximize skiable vertical. The exact location of each day can be adjusted based on weather, snow quality and available operations at the destination.

What guide-to-client ratios are applied during the trip?

Freeride and catski days work with a maximum ratio of 1 guide per 6 people, always seeking agile, safe operations adapted to the group's level. On the heliski day, the ratio is smaller and it operates with 1 guide per 4 people, to provide closer supervision on a more exclusive and demanding activity.

What is the heliski day like?

It is the main activity of the trip and is carried out with a helicopter operating three groups on the same day. Each group consists of 4 people with their guide, and the three subgroups rotate simultaneously on the mountain to maximize operation. The total time is 4 hours of effective flight, split among the three groups, and includes a mid-day stop to eat together while the helicopter refuels.

Can the heliski or entire trip be extended?

Yes, the program is proposed as a base and can be extended if you want to lengthen the experience. For heliski, the contracted minutes can be increased if the group wishes.

Is the order of the days fixed?

No. Cat ski and heliski days will be adjusted during the week according to weather and operational availability. This flexibility is an essential part of the program, as it prioritizes safety and takes better advantage of good weather windows and snow conditions.

What type of accommodation will you have?

The trip is planned with a 4* hotel in Mestia, in double rooms. All nights during the week at destination are in this accommodation, which serves as a comfortable base for ski days and resting after activity. A supplement can be paid for single rooms.

What meal plan is included?

Breakfasts and dinners in Mestia are included during the week. Lunches and snacks during the days are not included, so it is advisable to bring some on-the-go food for each activity day.

Is rescue insurance mandatory?

From 2026 it is mandatory to have medical insurance to enter Georgia. Additionally, for this trip it is highly recommended to contract medical and rescue insurance that expressly covers freeride, catski and heliski activities, as well as mountain assistance and possible evacuations.

What happens if catski or heliski cannot be done due to bad weather?

If any catski day cannot take place due to bad weather or other operational reasons beyond the client's control, €150 will be refunded for each unused catski day. In the case of heliski, if the activity cannot take place due to operational reasons such as bad weather or mechanical failure of the helicopter, the specific amount of €1,500 corresponding to the heli date reservation will be fully refunded once the trip has ended.

What is the payment and cancellation policy?

Reservation is secured with 30% of the total amount and the remaining 70% must be paid at least 60 days before departure. Full refund is available up to 24 hours after purchase, 100% refund up to 60 days prior, and 50% refund up to 45 days prior. After that period no refunds are given.

What safety equipment should I bring?

At minimum, you must bring DVA, shovel and probe, along with your ski or snowboard gear and suitable technical clothing for winter mountain days. A ski backpack, avalanche goggles, headlamp, thermos and snacks are also recommended. It's important to arrive with reviewed and ready-to-use equipment.

Is a minimum group required to run this trip?

Yes. The ideal minimum to operate this trip with minimum guarantees is 8 people, and the group can increase up to 12 participants. If fewer than 12 people are reached, catski and heliski days may be completed with external clients joining the group, aiming to meet the 12 necessary spots to properly operate these special activities.
