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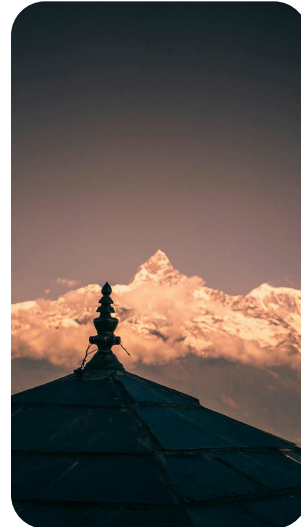
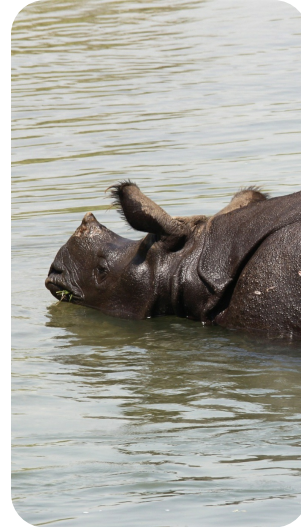
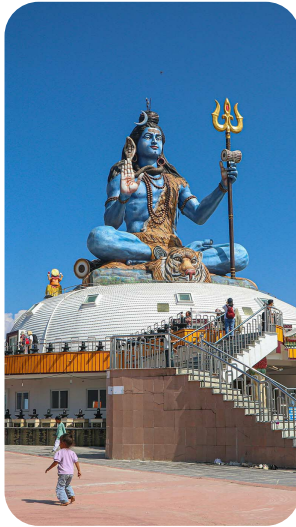


Included

Itinerary

DAY 1 : Arrival to Kathmandu

Reception at the airport, welcome and introduction. Transfer to the hotel. Hotel check-in.
Reception. Welcome dinner with cultural dance. Return to the hotel.

Accommodation: 3-star hotel

Meals: dinner

DAY 2 : Kathmandu Valley Tour

After breakfast, the cultural guide will take you to three incredible places: Boudhanath (one of the most sacred sites in Buddhism), the Pashupatinath Temple (also known as the little Varanasi), and the city of Bhaktapur. Three sites declared UNESCO World Heritage Sites.

Accommodation: 3-star hotel

Meals: breakfast

DAY 3 : Morning Flight to Pokhara

Transfer to the hotel. Refresh yourself. Visit Davis Falls, Mahendra Cave, and the Peace Stupa. Free afternoon to stroll around the city of Pokhara.

Accommodation: 3-star hotel

Meals: breakfast

DAY 4 : Flight to Chitwan for Jungle Safari

Flight to Chitwan. Check-in at the lodge, brief visit to the Tharu village if time permits, and in the evening, Tharu dance with dinner. Overnight at the jungle lodge.

Accommodation: 3-star hotel

Meals: breakfast + lunch + dinner

DAY 5 : Full day activities

Boat ride, jungle walk, elephant ride, and visit to the elephant breeding center.

Accommodation: 3-star hotel

Meals: breakfast + lunch + dinner

DAY 6 : Fly to Kathmandu

After breakfast, transfer to the airport to take the flight to Kathmandu. From the airport, visit the Swyambhunath Stupa and KTM Durbar Square, then return to the hotel.

Accommodation: 3-star hotel

Meals: breakfast

DAY 7 : Final departure

We can use the early morning to do last-minute shopping. We will be picked up from the hotel to transfer to the airport.

Meals: breakfast

Extra Services :

All our tours to Nepal can be extended and customized. These are the most popular additional services:

Morning flight to Everest: approximately 1-hour flight to see/touch Mount Everest (we will fly only 8 km from the summit). Includes round-trip transfer to your hotel. (Departure at 5:15 a.m. and return around breakfast time)

Extra night: An additional night in KTM (includes breakfast in shared or private room)

You can book additional services at the time of booking your trip or later.

Payment and cancellation policy

Initial Deposit: To secure your spot, an initial payment of 30% of the total trip cost is required at the time of booking.

Final Payment: The remaining amount, equivalent to 70% of the total, must be paid no later than 60 days before the departure date.

Extras: Additional trip costs such as insurance, flights, or other optional services must be paid in full at the time of booking.

Cancellation Insurance: The client may purchase trip cancellation insurance to obtain a refund of the total amount paid (according to the policy conditions).

The final user may cancel the booked trip and is entitled to a refund of amounts paid, except for penalties indicated. The client must also pay the agency the amounts indicated below once the trip is confirmed. If the trip is not carried out due to not reaching the minimum required participants, the client may keep the credit for future trips or request a full refund of the booking.

Cancellation Policy 3:

FULL REFUND UP TO 24 HOURS AFTER PURCHASE

Up to 60 days before the trip: 100% refund.

Up to 45 days before the trip: 50% refund.

For shorter periods than those described above, no refund will be given of the amount already paid.

*A handling fee of €250 applies.

*Cancellation fees for already issued bookings will not be refunded. If there are other non-refundable costs already issued, these will also not be refunded and will be deducted from the amount to be paid.

*The cancellation cost of issued flights is 100% of the amount.

Packing List

FUNCTIONAL CLOTHING:

- Softshell jacket (windproof, water-repellent, lightweight) for regular activities or Hardshell (waterproof Gore-Tex) only when very bad weather is forecasted
- Light waterproof pants
- Warm jacket: down jacket or preferably primaloft (since they handle water better)
- Light fleece
- Thermal pants and shirt for sleeping in the refuge
- Shorts and technical shirts (quick-drying)
- Swimsuits
- Underwear (cotton not recommended)

HEAD:

- Light cap
- Wool hat
- Neck gaiter
- Sunglasses

HANDS:

- Thin fleece gloves
- Trekking poles

FEET:

- Socks (cotton not recommended)
- Trail running shoes or trekking boots
- Trekking sandals with heel strap (optional)

BACKPACKS:

- Trail running vest or lightweight backpack
- Rain cover for backpack
- Duffle bag style canvas bag

ACCESSORIES:

- Headlamp and spare battery or batteries
- Sunscreen, lip balm, and after sun

FOOD/DRINK:

- Hydration system minimum 1L (Camelbak, canteen, or flexible bottle)
- Thermos (optional)
- Snacks, nuts, gels, hydration, enough energy bars, protein bars, mixed nuts, magnesium tablets, and recovery supplements

TRAVEL GEAR:

- Casual clothes
- Passport, visa, cash, insurance documents, vaccination card
- Microfiber towel
- First aid kit and medication
- Thermal blanket
- Mobile phone and watch with route tracker
- Power bank, camera, charging cables, headphones, selfie stick...

FAQs

How many days does it last and which places does it cover?

The program lasts 7 days full of contrasts: it starts and ends in Kathmandu, transfers to Phewa Lake and the mountains of Pokhara, and culminates with two days in the jungle of Chitwan National Park. This way, you combine historical heritage, Himalayan panoramas, and wildlife in a single itinerary.

What cultural and natural experiences are planned?

Todo está organizado con guías locales de habla española o inglesa.

¿Cómo es el safari en Chitwan y qué animales puedo ver?

The jungle resort includes two full days of canoe trips, jungle hikes, and 4x4 outings with an expert naturalist. Chitwan is famous for one-horned rhinoceroses, sambar deer, and the (rare) possibility of spotting the Bengal tiger.

Do I need to be very athletic to join?

No. The route is “designed so that everyone can do it” and only includes short walks without technical difficulty; it is classified as “accessible to all.” It’s enough to be used to walking for a few hours with comfortable footwear.

What exactly is included in the price?

The package covers private transfers between the airport and hotel, tourist-class hotels in Kathmandu, Pokhara, and Chitwan (breakfast included), internal transportation according to the itinerary, full board in Chitwan, cultural and naturalist guides, entry permits, and a welcome dinner.

What expenses should I expect besides the package?

International flights and the Nepal visa are not included, nor are lunches and dinners in Kathmandu and Pokhara (except the welcome dinner), drinks, travel insurance, and any costs resulting from strikes or landslides.

Where do you sleep and what amenities are provided?

You will spend the first and last night at the International Guest House in Kathmandu; the remaining nights will be in selected hotels in Pokhara and Chitwan. Accommodation is in shared rooms, although you can request a single room for an additional fee.

Are transfers within Nepal organized?

Yes; from arrival you will be picked up at the airport, and all ground transportation between cities and to the national park is reserved in private or tourist vehicles to avoid unforeseen issues and maximize your visit time.

Can you arrange flights and insurance for me?

Yes. For a €35 service fee, we offer flight search and purchase, monitoring fares to get the best price, and for €15 we handle the most suitable travel insurance (rescue, medical, and cancellation) with a 5% discount through IATI.

Can I add extras or customize the route?

Sure: they offer a panoramic flight over Everest (1 hour), additional nights in Kathmandu, and other services you can add when booking or later. Also, any Nepal tour can be privately extended according to your interests.

What are the passport and visa requirements?

It is important to have a valid passport with at least 6 months of validity. Nepal offers Visa on Arrival for most countries, but you can speed up the process and avoid queues upon landing by submitting your application online through this official web link. Upon arrival, head to the bank counter at Tribhuvan International Airport with the submission ID (confirmation page) you received when completing the Nepal visa application form. Pay the corresponding fee in cash and, after payment, proceed to the immigration officer's counter with your original passport to process the visa. For visa requirements, stay updated as immigration policies often change. Therefore, it is advisable to check the information closer to your planned travel date. Currently, as of February 2025, the tourist visa fees for Nepal are: 15 days: USD 30 30 days: USD 50 90 days: USD 125
