Itinerary

DAY 1 : ARRIVAL TO LONGYEARBYEN

We will prepare all the common equipment for the expedition and stay in an apartment in Longyearbyen, so we can depart early the next day.

Accommodation: Hotel

DAY 2 : SNOWMOBILE RIDE TO THE BASE CAMP

The journey begins with careful preparation and packing, as you get ready for an unforgettable adventure through central Spitsbergen. The excitement starts with a 165 km snowmobile ride from Longyearbyen to the remote Atomfjella region, a trip that takes around 5 to 6 hours in favorable conditions. As you traverse towering peaks and vast glaciers, prepare for several stops to enjoy the stunning views and stretch your legs.

Accommodation: Tent

Meals: breakfast + lunch + dinner

DAY 3-7: FREERIDING FROM BASE CAMP IN ATOMFJELLA

Our base camp in Atomfjella, located on the Galler glacier at 900 meters, offers an extraordinary Arctic skiing experience surrounded by rugged peaks and couloirs. The camp features a heated communal tent for dining and socializing, along with comfortable sleeping tents equipped with reindeer skins and mats. Each night, you will live the true Arctic adventure, watching for polar bears under the midnight sun. With a wide variety of terrain, we will embark on challenging ski routes, with daily plans adapted to weather, snow conditions, and group capability. Over six days, we will tackle elevations of up to 1200 meters, including the possibility of summiting Perriertoppen, the highest peak in Atomfjella.

Accommodation: Tent

Meals: breakfast + lunch + dinner

DAY 8: RETURN TO LONGYEARBYEN BY SNOWMOBILE

On the last day, we will dismantle the camp and pack our sleds to prepare for the snowmobiles coming from Longyearbyen to pick us up. We expect to return to Longyearbyen around 8:00 p.m. Tonight, we will stay in the apartment where we can enjoy a much-awaited shower!

Accommodation: Hotel

Meals: Lunch + breakfast

DAY 9 : END OF EXPEDITION AND GOODBYE

Accommodation: breakfast

EXTRA DAYS: OPTION TO EXTEND THE DURATION OF THE SKI TRIP

For full groups (minimum 6 people), departure dates, routes, and trip duration can be customized. Feel free to contact us.

This is a guideline route that will be adapted based on weather, avalanche risk, and group level to ensure maximum safety and enjoyment for all participants at all times. Meals will be adjusted according to the ski itinerary.

Payment and cancellation policy

Initial deposit: To secure your place, a 30% initial payment of the total trip cost is required at the time of booking.

Final payment: The remaining amount, equivalent to 70% of the total, must be paid no later than 90 days before the departure date.

Extras: Additional travel costs such as insurance, flights, or other optional services must be paid in full at the time of booking.

Cancellation insurance: The client may purchase trip cancellation insurance to be eligible for reimbursement of the full amount paid (subject to the insurance terms).

The end user may cancel the booked trip, being entitled to a refund of the amounts paid, except for the penalties indicated, but must also pay the Agency the amounts specified below once the trip is confirmed. If the trip does not take place due to not reaching the required minimum number of participants, the client may keep the credit for future trips or request a full refund of the deposit.

Cancellation policy 4:

FULL REFUND UP TO 24 HOURS AFTER PURCHASE

- Up to 90 days before the trip, 100% refund of the trip cost.
- Up to 60 days before the trip, 50% refund of the trip cost.
- For periods shorter than those described in the cancellation policy, no refund of the amount already paid will be made.

*Management fees of €250 apply

*Cancellation fees for already issued bookings will not be refunded. If there are other non-refundable costs already issued, these will also not be refunded and will be deducted from the amount to be refunded.

*The cost of canceling issued flights is 100% of the amount.

Packing List

Ski equipment

- Your ski equipment: skis/splitboard, boots, poles, helmet if desired
- Ski crampons
- Warm shoes to use at camp
- Ski skins with new adhesive (1x) or 2 pairs of skins
- Climbing harness
- Climbing slings (1x)
- Carabiners (1x)
- Crampones
- Ski bag and boot bag (mandatory)
- Avalanche equipment in backpack: shovel, probe, transceiver DVA (Mandatory)
- Other recommended/necessary items for this trip
- Valid driver's license
- Warm hat (e.g., wool hat)
- Balaclava/warm scarf (preferably wool, 1x)
- Ski socks (preferably wool, 2x)
- Thick thermal socks (preferably wool, 2x)
- Base layers (preferably wool, 2x)
- Insulating mid layers (e.g., wool sweater and fleece pants)
- Shell jacket and pants (wind and water resistant)
- Insulated waterproof mittens (No gloves!)
- Mittens or gloves for ski touring
- Warm down parka
- Backpack (should fit all gear, ~35 L) with straps to carry skis
- Neck gaiter
- Headlamp
- Water bottle or thermos, minimum 1 liter. If using a Camelbak-style pack, note the tube may freeze, so bring an auxiliary bottle.

- Sunscreen and lip protection
- Snacks (bars, gels, nuts...) for mountain eating during trekking routes
- Personal plate, fork, spoon, knife, and cup
- Personal equipment such as medication, hand sanitizer, etc.
- Optional: spare batteries, camera, power bank, first aid kit
- Winter sleeping bag (from -20 to -30 °C)
*available for rent at 150 NOK/day; notify us well in advance
- Recommended:
- Ski touring helmet
- Contact lenses if you wear glasses for driving (it's extremely difficult to wear glasses under snowmobile goggles)
- Camera and extra batteries (batteries drain very quickly in cold)
- Power bank for charging electronic devices
- Hand and foot warmers
- Thin liner gloves

*Maximum equipment weight per person, including skis, must not exceed 23 kg.

FAQs

How long does the expedition last and how is the day-to-day program structured?

The most common format with B4Experience covers 9 days: arrival and logistics in Longyearbyen, a 165 km snowmobile crossing to the camp (day 2), six full days of freeride from the base camp (days 3-7), camp breakdown and return to the capital (day 8), and expedition end the following day.

Where is Atomfjella and why is it a freeride paradise?

Atomfjella is located in the far northwest of Spitsbergen Island, in the Svalbard archipelago, Arctic. It is a freeride paradise due to its vast amount of untouched snow and rugged geography, featuring sharp peaks and varied slopes that provide technical and thrilling descents in a remote and wild environment. The microclimate and low human presence ensure excellent quality powder snow, ideal for demanding skiers.

How do we get to the base camp?

Access is by snowmobile convoy (one per every two people): about 5-6 hours crossing the Lomonosovfonna plateau and interior glaciers covering 165 km from Longyearbyen; a true Arctic adventure before putting on the skis.

What is the best time to travel?

Departures are concentrated between April and May, when there is 24-hour daylight, cold and stable snow, and the days are long enough to link several lines without extreme temperatures.

What kind of terrain and elevation will I be skiing?

What technical and physical level do I need?

Off-piste skiing skills and previous ski touring experience are required; the guide adapts each day to the group and conditions, but you should feel comfortable descending sustained slopes with a backpack and ascending 1,000 meters daily.

How many participants will there be and how many guides will accompany us?

Groups range from 6 to 12 skiers and always travel with at least two certified polar guides, ensuring safety and personalized attention both on the mountain and at the camp.

How is safety managed against bears and avalanches?

The guides carry rifles and flares for surveillance, a night watch shift is established, and daily snow briefings are conducted; each participant must carry avalanche gear and know how to use it.

What does the base price include?

Snowmobile transfers (helmet, suit, boots, fuel), full camp equipment, full board in the mountains, accommodation in Longyearbyen on the first and last night, two polar guides, rescue insurance, and all collective safety equipment.

Can the trip be customized or extended?

Yes; for full groups (minimum 6 people), dates can be changed, ski days extended, or custom routes planned, as long as logistics and polar conditions allow.

What is the accommodation like?

The program offers accommodation in shared tents. If you prefer a single room for your stay in Longyearbyen, please specify this when booking.
