Itinerary

DAY 1: WELCOME TO PUERTO NATALES

Located on the shores of the majestic Señoret Channel, Puerto Natales is much more than a picturesque Patagonian town: it is the essential starting point for exploring the world-famous Torres del Paine National Park. Upon arrival, a shared transfer will take you to your hotel. Before your adventure in Torres del Paine begins, you will receive an email with technical information and tips so that you can best prepare for your trip.

Includes:

- Shared transfer from Puerto Natales Airport to the hotel (approximately 15 minutes)
- 1 night's accommodation in Puerto Natales

Does not include: Dinner.

DAY 2: PUERTO NATALES TO TORRES DEL PAINE

Today you will take a transfer to the Puerto Natales bus station to connect with the 2:15 p.m. bus to Torres del Paine National Park. Once you arrive at the Puerto Natales bus station, our hostess will give you your welcome kit. You will arrive in the afternoon and then go to dinner and sleep in the Central Sector.

Includes:

- Shared transfer from the hotel in Puerto Natales to the bus terminal (5 minutes)
- Shared bus from the Puerto Natales terminal to Torres del Paine National Park (2.5 hours)
- Entrance to Torres del Paine National Park
- Dinner
- 1 night in the Central Sector.

Does not include: Box lunch.

DAY 3: TREKKING TO BASE TORRES VIEWPOINT

You will start early, heading to one of the most iconic places in the park, the Torres Base Viewpoint. During the first part, you will walk through the pampas and cross the Ascencio River, then climb about 3 km until you reach Paso de los Vientos, which will reward you with incredible views of the valley and lakes. You will continue until you reach the Chilean campsite, then enter a lenga forest and arrive at the moraine, where the hardest part of the trek begins. You will walk along a rocky trail until you reach the spectacular Mirador Base Torres. Later, you will begin your descent to the Central Sector for dinner and sleep.

Distance 8–10 hours / 19.5 km

Difficulty High

Ascent/Descent 750 meters

Includes:

- Self-guided trekking
- Breakfast, box lunch, and dinner
- 1 night in the Central Sector.

DAY 4: TREKKING IN THE CUERNOS SECTOR

You will walk around 13.5 km along Lake Nordenskjöld, Cerro Almirante Nieto, and the impressive Los Cuernos. Along the way, you will enjoy beautiful views of these mountains, hanging glaciers, lakes, and areas where you can appreciate the abundant flora and fauna of the area. You will arrive at the French Sector or the Cuernos Sector for dinner and overnight stay.

Distance 4.5–6.5 hours / 13.5 km

Difficulty Medium

Ascent/Descent 80 meters

Includes:

- Self-guided trekking
- Breakfast, box lunch, and dinner
- 1 night in the French Sector or Cuernos Sector.

DAY 5: TREKKING VALLE FRANCÉS

This day begins with one of the most important icons of the circuit, the French Valley. Then you will walk along a beautiful beach on Lake Nordenskjöld where you can observe the tranquility of the water or the impressive interplay between the wind and the water. Once you arrive at Campamento Italiano, you will begin the ascent (about 2 km) through forests in the French Valley. You will continue until you reach the Francés viewpoint, where you will be able to enjoy one of the most breathtaking views of the circuit. After this spectacular sight, you will begin the descent to the Paine Grande sector for dinner and rest.

Distance: 8–10 hours / 20.5 km

Difficulty: High

Ascent/Descent: 712 meters

Includes:

- Self-guided trekking
- Breakfast, box lunch, and dinner
- 1 night in the Paine Grande Sector.

DAY 6: TREKKING TO THE GREY SECTOR - BOAT TRIP ON LAKE PEHOÉ AND RETURN TO PUERTO NATALES

Today you will reach the third milestone of the circuit, a place that offers an unforgettable view of the park: the wonderful Grey Glacier. The trail begins by skirting Cerro Paine Grande, the highest point of the massif (3,050 meters), with incredible views of its hanging glaciers. Walking among ñirres, coigües, and notros, you will reach the first Grey Glacier viewpoint, where you will see numerous icebergs floating in it. You will continue walking with the imposing view of the Grey Glacier until you reach the Grey Refuge. Then you will return to the Paine Grande Sector where, at 6:40 p.m., you will take the catamaran that will take you to Pudeto. There you will find the bus that will take you back to Puerto Natales.

Distance 8–10 hours / 31.5 km

Difficulty High

Ascent/Descent 280 meters

Includes:

- Self-guided trekking
- Breakfast and box lunch
- Return catamaran across Lake Pehoé
- Shared bus from Torres del Paine to Puerto Natales
- Shared transfer from the Puerto Natales Bus Terminal to the hotel
- 1 night's accommodation in Puerto Natales

Does not include: Dinner.

DAY 7: FREE DAY IN PUERTO NATALES

Enjoy a well-deserved day off to explore the charming town of Puerto Natales at your own pace. You can stroll along the picturesque Seno de Última Esperanza, visit the historic pier, or explore the local craft shops and independent breweries. This is the perfect opportunity to savor Patagonian cuisine and recharge your batteries after your adventure in Torres del Paine.

Includes:

- 1 night's accommodation in Puerto Natales

Does not include: Lunch and dinner.

DAY 8: RETURN

Today you will take a transfer to Puerto Natales to connect with your connecting flights or continue your journey.

Includes:

- Shared transfer from the hotel to Puerto Natales airport (15-minute transfer).

Payment and Cancellation Policy

Initial Deposit: To secure your place, an initial payment of 30% of fees is required at the time of booking.

Final Payment: The remaining amount must be paid no later than 90 days before the departure date.

Extras: Additional travel costs, such as insurance, flights, or other optional services, must be paid in full at the time of booking.

Cancellation Insurance: The customer may take out travel cancellation insurance in order to obtain a refund of the full amount paid (according to the terms and conditions).

The end user may cancel the trip, with the right to a refund of the amounts paid, except for the penalties indicated, but must also pay the Agency the amounts indicated below once the trip has been confirmed. If the trip does not take place because the minimum number of participants has not been reached, the customer may save the credit for future trips or request a full refund of the reservation.

SPECIAL cancellation policy:

FULL REFUND UP TO 24 HOURS AFTER PURCHASE

- More than 90 days before the trip: the amount paid will be refunded.
- Between 89 and 70 days before the trip: 20% of the total amount will be retained and the rest will be refunded.

Between 69 and 45 days before the trip: 50% of the total amount will be retained and the rest will be refunded.

- Less than 44 days before the trip: the amount paid will not be refunded.

A €250 administration fee will be charged.

No refunds will be given for cancellations of reservations that have already been issued. If there are other non-refundable expenses that have already been incurred, these will also not be refunded and will be deducted from the amount to be paid.

The cost of canceling issued flights is 100% of the amount.

Packing List

Hiking Gear

- Trekking boots (already used)
- Short- and long-sleeved thermal shirts (dry-fit)
- Fleece / second thermal layer
- Warm jacket (down)
- Waterproof jacket
- Trekking pants
- Waterproof pants
- Socks
- Buff/multifunction neck warmer
- Thermal gloves
- Sun hat
- Thermal hat for cold weather
- Sandals/flip-flops for showers (optional)
- Backpack (50 liters maximum)
- Trekking poles
- Water bottle
- UV protection sunglasses
- Sunscreen (minimum SPF 50)
- Lip balm with SPF
- Personal toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, shampoo, etc.).
- Personal first aid kit
- Camera, charger, and adapter
- Mosquito repellent.

FAQs

What is the required physical and technical level?

You need to be in good physical condition. The route includes 6–8 hours of walking per day with moderate elevation changes. No technical experience is necessary, but you should have previous trekking experience.

Is it a guided tour?

No. It is a self-guided trek. You will receive all the information and maps you need to do it independently.

Is accommodation included?

Yes, 5 nights in shelters or campsites within the park and 2 nights in Puerto Natales are included.

What kind of food is offered?

Full board at the refuges or campsites (breakfast, box lunch, and dinner). In Puerto Natales, breakfast only.

Is there phone or internet coverage?

Most of the trek takes place without cell phone coverage. Some shelters have WiFi available for a fee.

Do I need a visa to enter Chile?

Citizens of the EU and most countries in the Americas do not need a visa. Please contact us if you have any questions.

How to get to Puerto Natales?

You can fly to Puerto Natales Airport or Punta Arenas Airport (Chile). Another option is to fly to El Calafate (Argentina) and take a bus to Puerto Natales from there.

Are there vegetarian/vegan options or options for people with allergies?

Yes. This must be indicated at the time of booking so that arrangements can be made with the shelters.

How many kilometers are covered?

Approximately 85 km in total over the five days of trekking.

What happens if I cannot complete a stage?

Evacuations or logistical support can be coordinated, but may involve additional costs.
