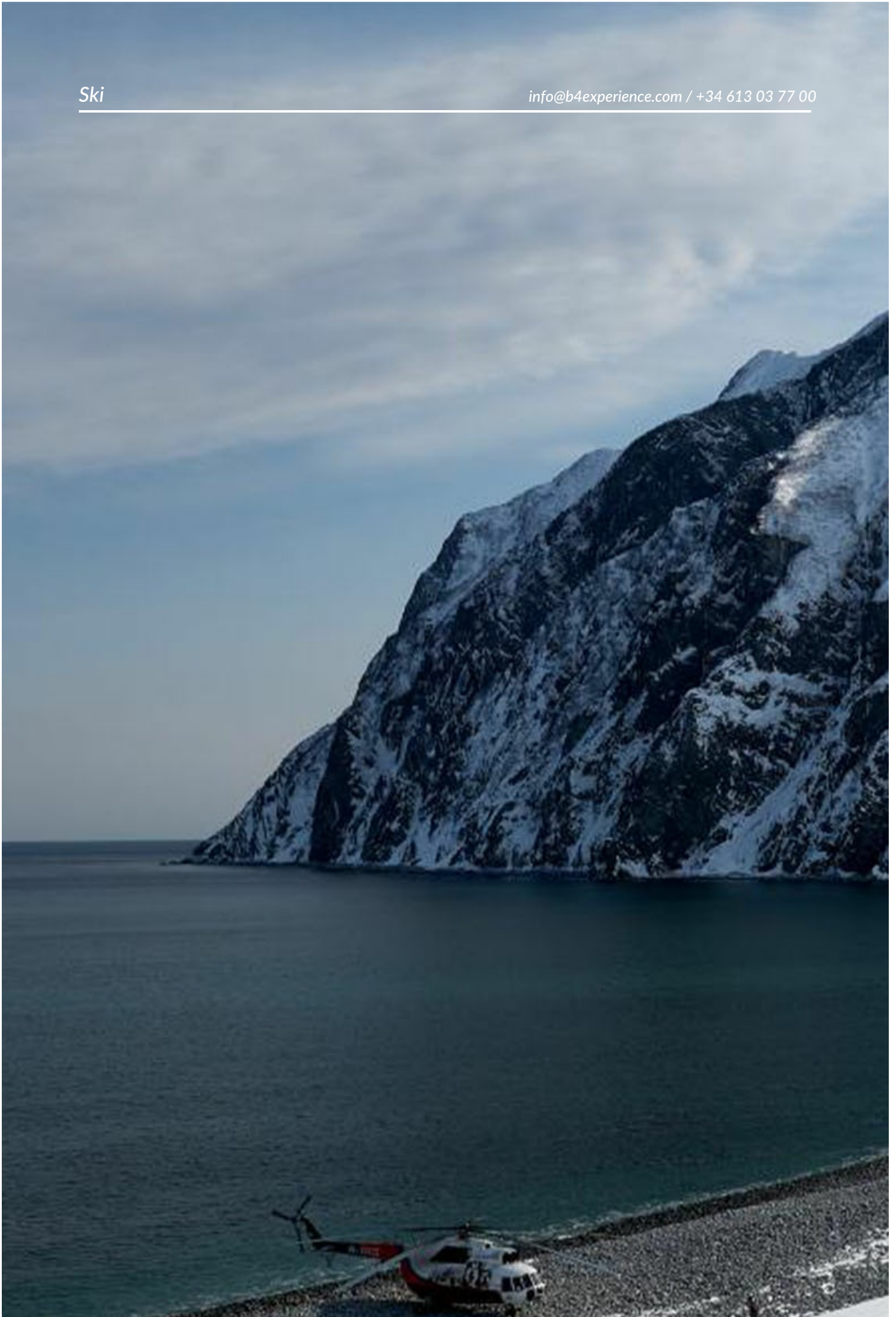

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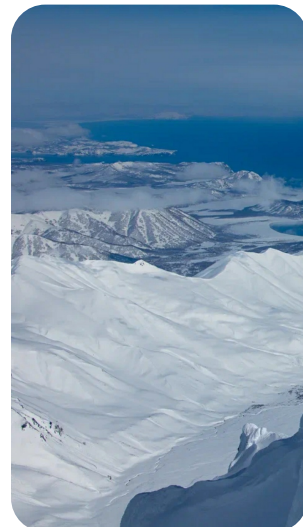
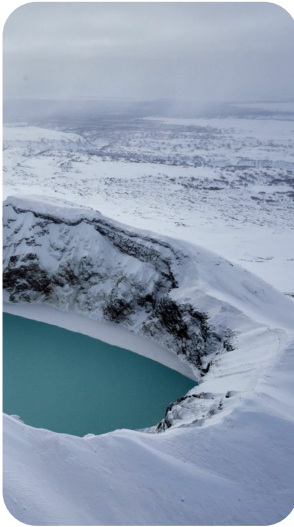

Itinerary

DAY 1 : ARRIVAL AND SAFETY BRIEFING

Arrival in Petropavlovsk-Kamchatsky, private transfer (30 minutes) to the base. Welcome reception and meeting with the guides. Safety briefing and review of the operational plan, avalanche equipment, and program guidelines. Dinner and final instructions for the following day's heliskiing.

DAY 2-7: HELISKIING ON VOLCANOES AND FJORDS

Daily heliskiing operations with MI-8MTV or MI-8AMT helicopter. Iconic objectives: descent into the crater of an active volcano, runs from summits down to the Pacific Ocean shore, and skiing in the Kachatska fjords. In case of bad weather, alternative activities are offered. A good day covers 7,000–10,000 m of vertical drop and ~2.5 hours of flight time.

Accommodation: Hotel *** (double occupancy)

Meals: Desayuno + picnic en la montaña (días de heliesquí) + Cena

DAY 8: FAREWELL AND RETURN FLIGHT

Breakfast at the hotel. Private transfer to Petropavlovsk-Kamchatsky airport for the return flight home. Program conclusion and end of services after checking equipment, settling any pending additional flight hours, and coordinating the airport transfer.

Payment and cancellation policy

Reserva inicial: Para asegurar tu plaza se requiere un pago inicial del 30% del importe total de los viajes al momento de realizar la reserva.

FAQs

How are the ski days distributed throughout the week?

The program includes 4 days of snow activities plus 2 free days. The standard group consists of 12–13 participants and 3 guides. This setup ensures efficient helicopter boarding and disembarkation, allows for close supervision of the group, and guarantees compliance with safety protocols and the dynamics established in the classic Kamchatka itinerary.

Where do we stay and how far is the helipad?

The program is based at Hotel *** with double occupancy for 7 nights. A higher-category hotel option is also available. Operations are streamlined thanks to the helipad located just 80 meters from the hotel, minimizing ground transfers and speeding up both morning departures and the return for après-ski, the thermal pool, and the sauna.

What exactly is included in the package?

Includes private airport–hotel–airport transfer, 7 nights in hotel, breakfasts, mountain picnic, dinner, 8 hours of helicopter flight and avalanche equipment (ABS backpack, transceiver, shovel and probe). There is also a nearby helipad and use of thermal water pool and sauna during the stay at the base.

What is the arrival airport and how do I get to Kamchatka?

The main airport is PKC – Petropavlovsk-Kamchatsky. There are direct flights from Moscow (SVO – Sheremetyevo) operated by Aeroflot. If you have trouble finding or booking flights, our team can assist you with the search and planning of your air travel. Just ask us!

What skiing and safety equipment is included?

The program includes avalanche safety equipment such as ARVA (beeper), probe, shovel, and also an ABS backpack. However, it does not include ski or snowboard rentals or boots, although you can rent all technical gear directly on site without any problem. There is a wide selection of modern equipment available for freeride and heliskiing.

Where do we sleep and what does the food include?

The accommodation is located in a natural park and close to the mountains, in a shared double room, next to the Vilyuchinsky volcano and with direct access to the helipad. During the ski days full board is included, with three meals a day: breakfast and dinner at the hotel, and picnic lunch on the route during the heliski or freeride day.

What type of helicopter is used for heliskiing?

The program is carried out using MI-8 or MI-8 MTV helicopters, robust models widely used in mountain operations due to their reliability and capacity. These helicopters are ideal for heliskiing in Kamchatka as they can comfortably transport large groups (up to 15 people), equipment, and guides, even in demanding winter conditions. Additionally, they offer ample interior space and guarantee direct departures from the hotel's helipad, facilitating daily logistics.

What are the passport and visa requirements?

It is important to have a valid passport with at least 6 months of validity. Russia welcomes citizens of 64 countries visa-free, while citizens of 55 countries can access an e-visa without visiting the consulate. For others, it is necessary to obtain a visa at the Russian consulate in their country, which can take up to 3 weeks; applications can be made 3 months before entry. A tourist invitation from us is required. The e-visa typically requires up to 4 days for approval. You will need specific information from us to apply; we will provide it to you after booking your trip. We can submit all the e-visa documentation on your behalf. You can add this service under "Extra Services" at checkout before booking your trip. The administrative fee for this service is €55 plus the visa fee, which will be billed to you later.

How many flight hours are included and what vertical drop can be skied?

The package includes 8 flight hours. As a reference, a good day of operation allows for 7,000–10,000 m of vertical drop and around 2.5 hours of flight, always subject to weather conditions and to the operational and safety decisions of the guides in order to follow the classic trip plan.

Can we add more helicopter hours if the group decides so?

Yes. Once the tour time is used up, the group may decide to continue skiing and purchase additional flight time. The extra runs are paid for at the end according to the cost of 1 flight hour.

What happens if we cannot use the hours due to bad weather or technical failures?

The 8 included flight hours are guaranteed. If they cannot be used due to bad weather or helicopter technical failures, the unused time will be refunded according to the cost of the flight hour: 38,000 RUB/h/person, billed per minute, applicable to the remaining unused hours of the package.

What happens if the weather prevents flying or skiing?

The program provides alternative activities in case of bad weather. The priority is safety and compliance with the protocols established by the guides. If the weather does not allow operations, the refund policy for unused flight time applies according to the conditions communicated for the tour.
